- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state board for

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of	the	
5	funds as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in		
6	the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal		
7	funds and other income, to the state board for vocational and technical education for the		
8	purpose of defraying the expenses of its various divisions, for the biennium beginning July 1,		
9	1999, and ending June 30, 2001, as follows:

19 SECTION 2. LEGISLATIVE INTENT - FARM MANAGEMENT PROGRAM FEES. It is

- 20 the intent of the fifty-sixth legislative assembly that all fees collected for farm management
- 21 programs pursuant to sections 6-09.10-02.1 and 6-09.10-06 be transferred to the state board
- 22 for vocational and technical education. The state board for vocational and technical education
- 23 shall distribute the fees as it determines necessary to state agencies and organizations
- 24 involved in providing farm management programs.
