5	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in t	his section, or so much of the
6	funds as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in	
7	the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal	
8	funds and other income, to the public service commission for the purpose of defraying the	
9	expenses of the public service commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 1999, and	
10	ending June 30, 2001, as follows:

19	SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 49-01-05 of the 1997 Supplement to the North	

20 Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

49-01-05. Salary of commissioners. The annual salary of a commissioner is fifty five sixty-four thousand four one hundred sixty-four thirty-six dollars through June 30, 1998 2000, and fifty-seven sixty-six thousand one hundred twenty sixty dollars thereafter. All fees received or charged by any commissioner for any act or service rendered in any official capacity, must

- 1 be accounted for and paid over by the commissioner monthly to the state treasurer and must be
- 2 credited to the general fund of the state.
