- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 57-36-07 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the size of packages for cigarette and roll-your-own tobacco sales or distribution; and
- 3 to declare an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 57-36-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is

6 amended and reenacted as follows:

57-36-07. Packaging - Presumption from possession. Cigarettes must be
packaged as follows:

9	1.	All cigarettes sold <u>or distributed</u> in this state must be in packages containing five
10		twenty or more cigarettes each.
11	2.	If the cigarettes are to be sold to an enrolled tribal member pursuant to section
12		57-36-11.1, within seventy-two hours of receipt by the licensee, a special stamp
13		must be affixed to each package of cigarettes indicating that it is not subject to tax.
14	3.	Each package of cigarettes displayed, exhibited, stored, or possessed in original
15		cartons or containers upon the premises where consumer sales are made is
16		conclusively presumed to be for sale to consumers.
17	<u>4.</u>	All packages of roll-your-own tobacco sold or distributed in this state must be in
18		packages containing at least 0.60 ounces of tobacco.
19	SEC	CTION 2. EMERGENCY. This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
