- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new chapter to title 15 of the North Dakota Century
- 2 Code, relating to national certification of teachers; and to provide an expiration date.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. A new chapter to title 15 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 **Definitions.** In this chapter, unless the context or subject matter otherwise requires:
- 7 1. "Board" means the education standards and practices board.
 - "Certification" means national board certification.
- 9 3. "National board" means the national board for professional teaching standards.
- "National board certification" means national board certification as provided by the
 national board for professional teaching standards.
 - "TEACH award" means an annual award granted to teachers maintaining national board certification.
 - 6. "TEACH program" means the program implementing this chapter to provide teachers throughout the state with information about this chapter, to assist teachers seeking national board certification, to provide scholarships to teachers seeking national board certification, and to grant TEACH awards.
- 18 **Board duties.** The board shall implement this chapter. The board shall:
 - Inform teachers of the existence of the TEACH program and the scholarships and services it provides to teachers seeking national board certification.
- 2. Collect and review scholarship applications from interested teachers.
- Create an applicant review committee for the purpose of identifying scholarship
 recipients for the TEACH program.

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- Ensure that all scholarship recipients and alternates receive adequate information
 regarding the level of commitment required to acquire national board certification.
 - Pay a two thousand dollar TEACH scholarship application fee to the national board for each approved scholarship applicant preparing for and taking the national board examination.
 - 6. Pay each school district five thousand dollars for each nationally certified teacher employed to teach in an approved school in the district, provided the district awards five thousand dollars to each nationally certified teacher so employed.

Applicant review committee duties. The applicant review committee consists of five individuals representing the education community as determined by the board. Members of the applicant review committee must be allowed necessary travel expenses, as may be approved by the board, which are payable in the same manner as travel expenses of other state officials.

It is the duty of the applicant review committee to select from a pool of applicants scholarship recipients and alternates. In determining scholarship recipients, the applicant review committee shall consider whether the applicant:

- 1. Has demonstrated a commitment to excellence in teaching;
- Meets all eligibility requirements for potential certification as established by the national board;
 - 3. Is employed as a teacher in a North Dakota approved school; and
- 4. Meets other requirements established by the board.
- 21 **SECTION 2. EXPIRATION DATE.** This Act is effective through June 30, 2001, and 22 after that date is ineffective.
