1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to review and monitor the 2 implementation of legislation enacted by the Fifty-sixth Legislative Assembly which provides for 3 the delivery of clerk of district court services through state funding and alternative methods. 4 **WHEREAS**, the Fifty-sixth Legislative Assembly is considering legislation to provide for 5 the delivery of clerk of district court services through alternative means, including state funding; 6 and 7 WHEREAS, the legislation is intended to ensure the local availability and delivery of 8 clerk of district court services while recognizing the state's responsibility to provide funding as 9 part of the implementation of the unified judicial system contemplated under Article VI of the 10 Constitution of North Dakota; and 11 **WHEREAS**, the legislation contemplates a delayed time of taking effect and for 12 transition periods in implementing alternative means of providing clerk of district court services; 13 and 14 **WHEREAS**, it is important that the implementation of this legislation be monitored to 15 identify any changes that may be necessary and to ensure that clerk of district court services 16 are provided in a manner that benefits the citizens of this state and the interests of the state 17 judicial system; 18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 19 OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN: 20 That the Legislative Council review and monitor the implementation of legislation 21 enacted by the Fifty-sixth Legislative Assembly which provides for the delivery of clerk of district 22 court services through state funding and alternative methods; and 23 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and 24 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to 25 the Fifty-seventh Legislative Assembly.
