- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 20.1-03-07.1 and subsection 4 of section
- 2 20.1-03-11 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to hunting by nonresidents.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 20.1-03-07.1 of the 1997 Supplement to the 5 North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - 20.1-03-07.1. Nonresident waterfowl hunting license required. Except as provided in section 20.1-03-07.2, a nonresident may not hunt waterfowl unless that person first obtains a nonresident waterfowl hunting license, in addition to a nonresident small game hunting license.
- 9 The nonresident waterfowl hunting license entitles the nonresident to hunt waterfowl for any
- 10 period of fourteen consecutive days or any two periods of seven consecutive days each during
- 11 any waterfowl hunting season and in specified waterfowl hunting zones. A license authorizing
- 12 two 7 day hunting periods may allow hunting in a different zone during each period. The
- 13 governor, in the governor's proclamation, shall specify various waterfowl hunting zones for
- 14 which nonresident waterfowl hunting licenses will be available, and may specify the number of
- 15 licenses which may be issued in each zone and the manner in which they are to be issued. A
- 16 nonresident is entitled required to purchase only one nonresident waterfowl hunting license per
- 17 year.

- 18 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subsection 4 of section 20.1-03-11 of the 1997
- 19 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 20 One percent of the total deer licenses and permits to hunt deer with guns to be
- issued in any unit or subunit as described in the governor's proclamation, including
- 22 licenses issued to nonresidents under subsection 3, must be allocated for
- 23 nonresidents. Notwithstanding the allocation under this subsection, upon payment
- 24 of the fee for a nonresident big game hunting license, a nonresident may purchase

- 1 any license remaining after the first lottery. Nonresidents may participate in any
- 2 <u>subsequent optional season.</u>
