- 1. If any funds appropriated for the 1997-99 biennium to the grants foundation aid and transportation line item in section 1 of chapter 13 of the 1997 Session Laws remain after completion of the April 1, 1999, distribution provided for in section 15-40.1-05, the superintendent of public instruction shall distribute the funds as a separate and additional per student payment on a prorated basis according to the average daily membership of each school district during the 1997-98 school year.
- 2. The board of each school district shall set aside not less than sixty percent of all moneys received under this section for use as supplemental salary payments to all teachers, administrators, and other professionally certified or licensed personnel employed by the district on a full-time or part-time basis during the 1998-99 school year.
- 3. The time, manner, and amount of distribution to school district employees must be determined through negotiation, as provided for by chapter 15-38.1.
- 19 **SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
