| 5 | WHEREAS, the Legislative Council has not conducted a comprehensive study of the |
| 6 | functions, responsibilities, funding, and operation of the state's adult correctional system since |
| 7 | the 1977-78 interim; and |
| 8 | WHEREAS, the Legislative Council has not conducted a comprehensive study of adult |
| 9 | correctional facility needs since the 1979-80 interim; and |
| 10 | WHEREAS, the prison population in North Dakota has increased by over 60 percent |
| 11 | from 1993 to 1998; and |
| 12 | WHEREAS, state general fund appropriations to the Department of Corrections and |
| 13 | Rehabilitation have increased by over 50 percent from the 1993-95 biennium to the 1997-99 |
| 14 | biennium; and |
| 15 | WHEREAS, the number of adult drug offenders incarcerated in North Dakota has |
| 16 | increased by over 460 percent from 1993 to 1998; and |
| 17 | WHEREAS, the Legislative Assembly has enacted numerous changes to sentencing |
| 18 | laws in North Dakota since 1993; and |
| 19 | WHEREAS, treatment and other programs that provide alternatives to incarceration |
| 20 | may reduce the number of inmates and reduce recidivism; |
| 21 | NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE |
| 22 | HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN: |
