BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the
- 5 general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$60,000, or so much
- 6 of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of public instruction for the purpose of
- 7 providing grants to nonprofit organizations for pilot programs for the establishment and
- 8 maintenance of a single point-of-entry early childhood and family center that provides a
- 9 convenient, one-stop access to activities, resources, and services for families with children
- 10 ages zero to six and whose purpose is to provide a full range of services through the
- 11 co-location and collaboration of early childhood professionals, for the period beginning
- 12 January 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003. The funds appropriated under this Act are subject
- 13 to the organization's receipt of \$5,000,000 from other sources.
