## FIRST ENGROSSMENT with Senate Amendments ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1444

- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide loans to individuals preparing to teach at grade levels or in content
- 2 areas having declared teacher shortages.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. Loans - Teacher shortages - Repayment.

- 5 1. The state board of higher education shall administer a student loan program for 6 individuals preparing to teach at grade levels or in content areas identified as 7 having teacher shortages.
- 8 2. The board shall annually identify the elementary and high school grade levels or
  9 content areas in which teacher shortages exist.
- Any individual may apply to the state board of higher education for a student loan,
   payable in the amount of one thousand dollars for each year the individual is
   enrolled as a full-time student in a teacher preparation program, with the declared
   intention to teach at a grade level or in a content area identified by the board as
   one in which teacher shortages exist. An individual may receive a maximum of
   five one thousand dollar loans under this section.
- 16 4. The board shall consider all applications under this section in chronological order.
- The board shall annually forgive one thousand dollars of any amount loaned to an
  individual under this section upon notification that the individual has completed a
  full year of teaching in a school district or nonpublic school in this state at a grade
  level or in a content area identified by the board as one in which teacher shortages
  exist.
- 6. If an individual does not meet the requirements of subsection 5 with respect to
  forgiveness of a loan, the individual shall proceed with loan repayments at the time
  and in the manner set forth by the board.
