1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 15.1-09-02 and 15.1-09-27 and subsection 1

2 of section 15.1-09-30 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to terms of Fargo board of

3 education members; and to declare an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15.1-09-02 of the 1999 Supplement to the North
6 Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

15.1-09-02. School boards - Terms of office. The term of each elected member of a
school board is three years, except when the member is completing the unexpired term of
another. The term of office for a school board member begins at the annual meeting in July
following the member's election and continues until a successor is elected and qualified. The
term of office for a member of the board of education of the city of Fargo begins at the first
regular monthly meeting after the annual school district election held on the third Tuesday of
April.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 15.1-09-27 of the 1999 Supplement to the North
 Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

16 15.1-09-27. Organization of school board - Election of president. At the annual
 meeting, school board members shall elect from among themselves a president to serve for
 one year. Members of the Fargo board of education shall elect their president and a vice
 president at the first regular monthly meeting following the election of new board members.
 20 SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 15.1-09-30 of the 1999
 21 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

Each school board shall hold an initial meeting during the month of July following
 the annual election, except that the initial meeting for the board of education of the
 city of Fargo must take place at the time of the first regular monthly meeting after

its annual election. The president of the school board shall select a meeting date
 that is convenient to the other board members and shall provide board members
 with written notice of the meeting.
 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY. This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
