1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a legislative council study of issues relating to resident and

2 nonresident hunting in this state.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL STUDY OF RESIDENT AND NONRESIDENT 4 HUNTING. During the 2001-2002 interim, the legislative council shall study issues relating to 5 6 resident and nonresident hunting in this state. The study must include the number of licenses 7 issued to residents and nonresidents and the fees for those licenses, the time period for which 8 a license is valid, whether zones should be established, effects on landowners, effects on 9 guides and outfitters, the economic impact of nonresident hunters on the state of North Dakota, 10 and how states bordering North Dakota are addressing issues relating to nonresident and 11 resident hunting. The legislative council shall report its findings and recommendations, 12 together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the fifty-eighth 13 legislative assembly.
