## ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1193

Introduced by

1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 28-26-06 of the North Dakota Century Code,  
2 relating to the assessment of legal fees following a judgment.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 28-26-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is  
5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **28-26-06. Disbursements taxed in judgment.** In all actions and special proceedings,  
7 the clerk of district court shall tax as a part of the judgment in favor of the prevailing party ~~his~~  
8 the following necessary disbursements ~~as follows~~:

- 9 1. The legal fees of witnesses; sheriffs; clerks of district court; the clerk of the  
10 supreme court, if ordered by the supreme court; process servers; and of referees  
11 and other officers;
- 12 2. The necessary expenses of taking depositions and of procuring evidence  
13 necessarily used or obtained for use on the trial;
- 14 3. The legal fees for publication, when publication is made pursuant to law;
- 15 4. The legal fees of the court reporter for a transcript of the testimony when such  
16 transcript is used on motion for a new trial or in preparing a statement of the case;  
17 and
- 18 5. The fees of expert witnesses. ~~Such~~ The fees must be reasonable fees as  
19 determined by the court, plus ~~his~~ actual ~~expense~~ expenses. The following are  
20 nevertheless in the sole discretion of the trial court:
  - 21 a. The number of expert witnesses who are allowed fees or expenses;
  - 22 b. The amount of fees to be paid such allowed expert witnesses, including an  
23 amount for time expended in preparation for trial; and

- 1                   c.    The amount of costs for actual expenses to be paid ~~such~~ the allowed expert  
2                   witnesses.
