- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 28-26-06 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the assessment of legal fees following a judgment.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 28-26-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is 5 amended and reenacted as follows:

28-26-06. Disbursements taxed in judgment. In all actions and special proceedings,
the clerk <u>of district court</u> shall tax as a part of the judgment in favor of the prevailing party his
<u>the following</u> necessary disbursements as follows:

- The legal fees of witnesses; sheriffs; clerks of district court; the clerk of the
 supreme court, if ordered by the supreme court; process servers; and of referees
- 11 and other officers;
- The necessary expenses of taking depositions and of procuring evidence
 necessarily used or obtained for use on the trial;
- 14 3. The legal fees for publication, when publication is made pursuant to law;
- The legal fees of the court reporter for a transcript of the testimony when such
 transcript is used on motion for a new trial or in preparing a statement of the case;
 and
- 5. The fees of expert witnesses. Such <u>The</u> fees must be reasonable fees as
 determined by the court, plus his actual expense <u>expenses</u>. The following are
 nevertheless in the sole discretion of the trial court:
- 21 a. The number of expert witnesses who are allowed fees or expenses;
- b. The amount of fees to be paid such allowed expert witnesses, including an
 amount for time expended in preparation for trial; and

- 1 c. The amount of costs for actual expenses to be paid such the allowed expert
- 2 witnesses.
