- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 15.1-19-03 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to a period of silence, the recitation of prayers, and the pledge of allegiance in schools.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15.1-19-03 of the 1999 Supplement to the North
 Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 15.1-19-03. Period of silence Recitation of prayer Pledge of allegiance. A The
- 7 <u>board of a school district shall allow a</u> classroom teacher may require that the students <u>to</u>
- 8 observe a period of silence for meditation, reflection, or prayer for up to one minute at the
- 9 beginning of each schoolday. A In addition, the school board may require that students
- 10 observe a period of silence for up to one minute at the beginning of each schoolday authorize
- 11 the voluntary recitation of a prayer by a teacher or student and the pledge of allegiance. The
- 12 board or the teacher shall inform students that these exercises are not meant to influence an
- 13 individual's religious beliefs, rather that the exercises allow students to learn about this
- 14 country's freedoms, including the freedom of religion.
