- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 43-01-18 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to fees charged by abstracters.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 43-01-18 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - **43-01-18. Fees chargeable by abstracter.** An abstracter may charge <u>no more than</u> the following fees, and no more for making and certifying to an abstract:
- 8 1. For each entry on an abstract or continuation thereof, five dollars.
- 9 2. For a complete certification covering the records of the several county offices, sixty

 10 seventy-five dollars.
 - 3. For a certification covering lands in excess of one quarter section [64.75 hectares] in the same abstract of title an additional fee of nine dollars, for each quarter section [64.75 hectares] or portion thereof in excess of one, may be charged.
 - 4. For a certification covering premises in more than one block in any subdivision in the same abstract of title, an additional fee of nine dollars, for such the premises in each additional block in excess of one, may be charged.
 - For each name searched for judgments, real estate taxes, bankruptcy proceedings, federal tax liens, state tax liens, mechanics' liens and mechanics' lien notices, three dollars and fees charged to the abstracter by governmental agencies or governmental entities.
 - For all miscellaneous instruments, two dollars for the first one hundred words, and one dollar for each additional hundred words or fraction thereof.
 - 7. Such The fees as may be fixed by special statute.
