- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 40-63-04 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to renaissance zone income tax exemptions for certain purchases or
- 3 leases of business property in small cities; and to provide an effective date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- **SECTION 1.** A new subsection to section 40-63-04 of the 1999 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- An individual taxpayer who makes an investment of more than seventy-five
 thousand dollars in a new or expanding business located in a city of less than two
 thousand five hundred population is exempt from up to ten thousand dollars of
 personal income tax liability as determined under section 57-38-29 or 57-38-30.3
 for five taxable years. The exemption under this subsection is first allowed in the
 taxable year of the investment.
- SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act is effective for taxable years beginning after
- 14 December 31, 2000.
