- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 40-63-04 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to renaissance zone income tax exemptions for the purchase or
- 3 expansion of business property in small cities; and to provide an effective date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. A new subsection to section 40-63-04 of the 1999 Supplement to the 6 North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows: 7 An individual taxpayer who purchases a new business or expands the taxpayer's 8 existing business is exempt up to ten thousand dollars of personal income tax liability as determined under section 57-38-29 or 57-38-30.3 for five taxable years, 9 10 beginning with the date of purchase or completion of the expansion. The cost of 11 the acquisition or expansion must exceed seventy-five thousand dollars and must 12 be an approved zone project. The new or expanding business must be located in 13 a city of less than two thousand five hundred population. 14 **SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Act is effective for taxable years beginning after
