- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 26.1-36.4 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to health insurance utilization reports.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 26.1-36.4 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Health insurance utilization reports.

- 1. Once each calendar year, any employer with fifty or more employees is entitled to a report from the insurer or administrator of that employer's employee health plan which includes a monthly accounting for the most recent twenty-four-month period of the total number of insured or covered employees, the total premiums paid, and the total benefits paid on behalf of the employer's health plan.
- 2. Insurers shall provide the report pursuant to subsection 1 to an employer within fifteen days of receipt of a request for the information.
- The information provided pursuant to subsection 1 may not identify specific employee claims or other confidential health care information.
- 4. Upon notification of termination of health insurance, the terminated insurer, at the request of the employer and within thirty days of the request, shall supply the succeeding or new insurer a report of all deductibles and coinsurance payments by the employer for the most recent benefit period.
