1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 2 of section 15-59-01 of the North Dakota

2 Century Code or in the alternative to amend and reenact subsection 4 of section 15.1-32-01 of

3 the North Dakota Century Code, relating to students with disabilities.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. If House Bill No. 1045 does not become effective,

6 subsection 2 of section 15-59-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted7 as follows:

8	2.	" Child <u>Student</u> with disabilities" means a child <u>an individual</u> who has reached the
9		third birthday, and is at least three years of age but who has not reached the age
10		of twenty-one years by midnight of August thirty-first, before September first of the
11		year in which the individual turns twenty-one and who because of mental, physical,
12		emotional, or learning characteristics requires regular or special education and
13		related aids and services designed to meet individual education the individual's
14		educational needs. This The term includes children an individual who are is
15		mentally retarded, hard of hearing impaired, deaf, deaf-blind, speech or language
16		impaired, visually impaired, seriously emotionally or behaviorally disturbed,
17		specific learning disabled, orthopedically impaired, otherwise health impaired, or
18		autistic, or and an individual who has a specific learning disability, a traumatic
19		brain injured injury, or other health impairment.
20	SEC	CTION 2. Subsection 4 of section 15.1-32-01 of the North Dakota Century Code as
21	created by I	House Bill No. 1045, as approved by the fifty-seventh legislative assembly, is
22	amended ar	nd reenacted as follows:

4. "Student with disabilities" means an individual who is at least three years of age
but who has not reached the age of twenty-one before September first of the year

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1	in which the individual turns twenty-one and who because of mental, physical,
2	emotional, or learning characteristics requires regular or special education and
3	related services designed to meet the individual's educational needs. The term
4	includes an individual who is mentally retarded, hearing impaired, deaf, deaf-blind,

7	learning disability, a traumatic brain injury, or other health impairment.
