- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 3 of section 39-12-02 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the fees for special vehicle permits; and to provide an expiration date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 3 of section 39-12-02 of the 1999 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - 3. An appropriate charge must be made for each permit and all funds collected hereunder by the highway patrol must be deposited in the state highway fund for use in the construction and maintenance of highways and operating expenses of the department of transportation. Official or publicly owned vehicles may not be required to pay charges for permits. Notwithstanding the minimum fee schedule, the permit fee charge for moving oversized or overweight vehicles must be one-half that charged for other vehicles of a similar nature if the cargo originates in and the vehicle is transporting the tower, blade, or any portion of a machine used to generate electrical energy through wind to a location in this state. The minimum fee for selected charges is as follows:
 - a. The fee for the ten percent weight exemption, harvest and wintertime, is fifty dollars per month.
 - b. The fee for a non-self-issuing interstate permit is ten dollars per trip.
 - c. The fee for special mobile equipment is twenty-five dollars per trip.
- 20 d. The fee for engineering is twenty-five dollars per trip.
- e. The fee for filing a permit is five dollars per trip.
- f. The fee for a single trip permit is twenty dollars per trip.
- 23 **SECTION 2. EXPIRATION DATE.** This Act is effective through July 31, 2003, and 24 after that date is ineffective.
