1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 37-02-06 and 37-03-02 of the North Dakota

2 Century Code, relating to the adjutant general's office.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 37-02-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is 5 amended and reenacted as follows:

- 6 **37-02-06. Staff of governor.**
- 7 <u>1.</u> The staff of the governor consists of:
- 8 1. <u>a.</u> The adjutant general who shall be is the chief of staff and shall must hold the 9 rank of brigadier general, provided that in the event of. However, if an officer 10 having a total of twenty years or more commissioned service in the armed 11 forces he shall, the adjutant general must hold the grade rank of major 12 general.
- 2. <u>b.</u> An assistant adjutant general for the department of the army who shall must
 hold a rank consistent with his that individual's length of service and federal
 laws and regulations, but not to exceed the rank of brigadier general.
- 163.c.An assistant adjutant general for the department of the air force who shall17must hold a rank consistent with his that individual's length of service and18federal laws and regulations, but not to exceed the rank of brigadier general.
- 4. Not more than two assistant adjutants general to administer the military records or
 perform other duties as may be assigned to the adjutant general by law or the
 governor.

8	SE	CTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 37-03-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is
9	amended a	nd reenacted as follows:
10	37-	03-02. Assistant adjutants general - Appointment - Qualifications - Duties. An
11	assistant a	djutant general for army, and an assistant adjutant general for air force <u>, and other</u>
12	assistant a	djutants general authorized by a table of organization prescribed by the laws or
13	regulations	of the United States, may be appointed by the governor upon the recommendation
14	of the adjut	ant general. At the time of his appointment, each Each assistant adjutant general
15	for army or	for air force must have had not less than five years' military commissioned service
16	in the arme	d forces of this state or of the United States, must have held a commission in the
17	armed forc	es of this state or of the United States for at least three years, North Dakota national
18	guard imme	ediately preceding the appointment and must have attained the rank of captain in the
19	national gu	ard of this state lieutenant colonel. Upon his appointment, each assistant adjutant
20	general for	army or for air force shall must have such the rank as is consistent with federal laws
21	and regulat	ions. The assistant adjutant general for army and the assistant adjutant general for
22	air force sh	all respectively have general supervision over the training of the troops and the
23	administrat	ion of the affairs of their respective departments. The governor shall deputize an
24	assistant a	djutant general to serve as deputy adjutant general and such deputy, regardless of
25	rank, shall	have all of the powers and duties of the adjutant general, except in such instances
26	where his a	authority has been restricted by the adjutant general, and he shall serve as acting
27	adjutant ge	neral in case of absence of the adjutant general or his inability to act. An assistant
28	adjutant ge	neral for the department of military records may be appointed by the governor upon
29	recommen	dation of the adjutant general from among the active or retired officers of the North
30	Dakota nat	ional guard. The assistant adjutant general for military records shall must have such
31	the rank as	is consistent with his experience and length of service.
