BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. Inspection of certain imported agricultural products - Continuing appropriation. The agriculture commissioner shall inspect or contract for the inspection of any agricultural product imported into this state from another country if the selling price of the agricultural product to the purchaser in this state is lower than the selling price of the product to purchasers in the exporting country. The commissioner shall impose upon the importer of the product an inspection fee not to exceed the difference between the price charged the importer and maximum selling price of the product in the exporting country during the thirty days preceding the importation of the product into this state. The commissioner may adopt rules to implement this section. The commissioner shall deposit any fees collected under this section into a special inspection fund in the state treasury. There is appropriated on a continuing basis to the agriculture commissioner any inspection fees collected under this section and deposited in the special inspection fund to be used for the purpose of conducting or contracting for inspections as required in this section. For the purposes of this section, "agricultural product" means crops, crop products, or plants intended for human consumption or as a feed for animals intended for human consumption, but does not include products for the sole consumption of the transporter or the transporter's family.
