1 A BILL for an Act to provide for collection of wage information of organizations that receive

2 governmental economic development assistance.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. State and political subdivision collection of wage information -5 Economic development assistance. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, each state 6 agency or entity and every political subdivision as defined under section 37-19.1-01 shall 7 collect, maintain, and make available at no cost to the public information regarding wages paid 8 by every organization that receives economic development assistance from that agency, entity, 9 or political subdivision after June 30, 2001. For purposes of this section, economic 10 development assistance includes grants, financing, in-kind assistance that exceeds one 11 thousand dollars, tax waivers, tax credits, interest buydowns, and other types of financial 12 incentives. Wage information must include the high, low, median, and average wages provided 13 by the organization and the number of individuals receiving these wages.
