1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 20.1-03-07.1 of the North Dakota Century

2 Code, relating to nonresident waterfowl hunting.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 20.1-03-07.1 of the 1999 Supplement to the
North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

6 20.1-03-07.1. Nonresident waterfowl hunting license required. Except as provided 7 in sections 20.1-03-07.2 and 20.1-03-07.3, a nonresident may not hunt waterfowl unless that 8 person first obtains a nonresident waterfowl hunting license, in addition to a nonresident small 9 game hunting license. The Except for zone 1, the nonresident waterfowl hunting license 10 entitles the nonresident to hunt waterfowl for any period of fourteen consecutive days, any 11 period of seven consecutive days, or any two periods of seven consecutive days each. A 12 Except for zone 1, a license authorizing the fourteen-day hunting period allows hunting in a 13 specified waterfowl hunting zone. A license authorizing one 7 day hunting period allows 14 hunting statewide. A area and a license authorizing two 7-day hunting periods allows hunting in 15 a specified zone area during each period. The governor, in the governor's proclamation, shall 16 specify various waterfowl hunting zones areas within each zone for which nonresident 17 waterfowl hunting licenses will be available, and may specify the number of licenses which may 18 be issued in each zone and the manner in which they are to be issued. A nonresident 19 waterfowl hunting license for zone 1 entitles the nonresident to hunt waterfowl for the entire 20 season. Zones are: 21 Zone 1 - That portion of the state north of North Dakota highway 200, west of North 1. 22 Dakota highway 1, and east of United States highway 83.

- 23 2. Zone 2 The remainder of the state.
- A nonresident is entitled to purchase only one nonresident waterfowl hunting license per year.
