- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 48-05-01 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the display of flags at the state capitol.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 48-05-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is
amended and reenacted as follows:

6 48-05-01. Flags displayed on public institutions. The flag of the United States of 7 America shall must be displayed upon all state institutions between the hours of nine 8 o'clock a.m. and four o'clock p.m. of each day, weather permitting. Upon the written request of 9 any individual to, and upon receiving the approval of, the capitol grounds planning commission, 10 the flags of each federally recognized Indian tribe in this state or a flag representing the origin 11 of any ethnic group in the state may be displayed at the state capitol. The state shall assume 12 the cost of displaying any flag at the state capitol. The officials in charge of the various state 13 institutions shall make the necessary arrangements for carrying out the provisions of this 14 section.
