1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 54-07-01 of the North Dakota
2 Century Code, relating to gubernatorial reports to the budget section of the legislative council
3 concerning incentives for value-added businesses.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1.** A new subsection to section 54-07-01 of the 1999 Supplement to the
6 North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

7 Shall report to the budget section of the legislative council concerning value-added
8 businesses commencing operations in the state after July 1, 2001. The governor
9 shall report at each meeting of the budget section held during an interim between
10 sessions of the legislative assembly on progress made to date on value-added
11 businesses. For each new business created, the report must include the name of
12 the business; an itemized list of the type and total amount of each economic
13 incentive provided by the state or a political subdivision to the business; the
14 number of jobs created and the wages paid for those jobs, including the high, low,
15 medium, and average wage; and the products being or intended to be produced.
