- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 43-31-02 and 43-31-03 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to detection of deception examiners.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 43-31-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is 5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 43-31-02. Device or instrument to be used. Every

- 7 <u>1.</u> <u>An</u> examiner shall <u>may</u> use an:
- 8a.An instrument which that records permanently and simultaneously the9subject's cardiovascular and respiratory patterns as minimum standards, but10such an instrument may record additional physiological changes pertinent to11the detection of deception; or
- b. Any other instrument or device to detect deception or to verify truth of
 statements which meets minimum instrumentation standards and which the
 examiner has been certified to operate.
- An examiner shall, upon Upon written request of a person examined, an examiner
 shall make known the results of such test to the person examined within five days
 of receipt of the written request.
- 18 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 43-31-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is
 19 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 20 43-31-03. Unlawful acts. It Except for a law enforcement officer in the course of the
- 21 officer's full-time employment with a federal, state, or local law enforcement agency who is
- 22 <u>certified to operate a device or instrument described in section 43-31-02, it</u> is unlawful for any
- 23 person to administer detection of deception examinations, or attempt to hold himself oneself out
- as an examiner, without a license issued by the attorney general of the state.
