provide for a legislative council study; to provide an effective date; and to provide an expiration
date.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 57-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is 7 created and enacted as follows:

8 Agricultural property true and full valuation limitation for 2001 and 2002. 9 Notwithstanding section 57-02-27.2 or any other provision of law, the true and full value of a 10 parcel of agricultural property in taxable years 2001 and 2002 may not be more than the true 11 and full value of that parcel for taxable year 1999. 12 SECTION 2. LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL STUDY. The legislative council shall consider 13 studying the valuation and assessment of agricultural lands for property tax purposes and 14 report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the 15 recommendations, to the fifty-eighth legislative assembly. 16 SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE - EXPIRATION DATE. Section 1 of this Act is

effective for the first two taxable years beginning after December 31, 2000, and is thereafterineffective.
