- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 45-11-01 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the definition of a fictitious name.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 45-11-01 of the 1999 Supplement to the North
 Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 45-11-01. Partnership Use of fictitious partnership name.
 - 1. As used in this section, "fictitious name" means a counterfeit, alias, feigned, or pretended name taken by a person, differing in some essential particular from the person's true name. The term does not include the use of an individual's true name or an individual's surname within a partnership name if the true name or surname comprises a substantial portion of the name and the name is not used in a deceptive manner.
 - 2. Any partnership transacting business in this state under a fictitious name or under a designation that does not show the names of the persons interested as partners must file a fictitious name certificate with the secretary of state, together with a filing fee of twenty-five dollars. When a partnership has more than two members, an additional three dollars must be paid for each additional member not to exceed two hundred fifty dollars. A limited partnership or a foreign limited partnership transacting business under a name filed under chapter 45-10.1 and as provided in section 45-11-03 or a partnership transacting business under a name filed under section 45-13-05 is not required to file a fictitious name certificate under this section.
 - 3. The fictitious name:

- 4. <u>a.</u> May not contain the word "corporation", "company", "incorporated", "limited liability company", or "limited", or an abbreviation of any of those words. This subsection does not preclude the word "limited" from being used in conjunction with the word "partnership".
 - 2. <u>b.</u> May not be the same as or deceptively similar to any corporate name, limited liability company name, trade name, partnership name on file with the secretary of state, limited partnership name, foreign limited partnership name, or fictitious name certificate on file with the secretary of state, unless there is filed with the fictitious name certificate a written consent of the holder of the similar name to use the proposed name and a filing fee of ten dollars.
