1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact two new sections to chapter 39-10.1 of the North Dakota

2 Century Code, relating to bicycle helmets and restraining seats; to amend and reenact section

3 39-10.1-01 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to bicycles; and to provide a penalty.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 39-10.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 created and enacted as follows: 7 **Definitions.** In this chapter, unless the context otherwise requires, "protective bicycle 8 helmet" means a piece of headgear that meets or exceeds the impact standards for protective bicycle helmets set by the United States consumer products safety commission, the American 9 10 society for testing and materials, the American national standards institute, or the Snell 11 memorial foundation. 12 SECTION 2. A new section to chapter 39-10.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is 13 created and enacted as follows: 14 Requirements for helmet and restraining seat use. 15 1. A minor may not operate a bicycle or be in a cart pulled by a bicycle unless the minor wears a protective bicycle helmet of good fit fastened securely upon the 16 17 head with the straps of the helmet. 18 An individual who weighs less than forty pounds [18.14 kilograms] or is less than 2. 19 forty inches [101.60 centimeters] in height must be properly seated in and 20 adequately secured to a restraining seat or, if in a cart pulled by a bicycle, must be 21 properly seated in and adequately secured to the cart. 22 SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. Section 39-10.1-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is 23 amended and reenacted as follows:
