4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. Administrative rules committee review of existing administrative rules.

- 1. The administrative rules committee shall establish a schedule for review of all administrative rules. Upon request by the committee, an administrative agency shall brief the committee on its existing administrative rules and point out any provisions that appear to be obsolete and any areas in which statutory authority has changed or been repealed since the rules were adopted or amended.
- An agency may amend or repeal a rule if, after consideration of the rule by the
 administrative rules committee, the agency and committee agree that the rule
 amendment or repeal eliminates a provision that is obsolete or no longer in
 compliance with law.
- 3. If the administrative rules committee finds that, with regard to a rule reviewed under this section, any consideration exists under section 28-32-03.3 for which the committee may declare a rule void, then the procedures of section 28-32-03.3 apply with regard to that rule and the committee may proceed according to that section with consideration of whether to find the rule void.
