BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. If House Bill No. 1045 does not become effective, section
 15-38.1-04 of the 1999 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and
 reenacted as follows:
 - 15-38.1-04. Compensation of commission and factfinders. Members of the commission are entitled to receive compensation at the rate of sixty-two eighty dollars and fifty eents per day and reimbursement for expenses, as provided by law for state officers, for attending commission meetings or performing duties directed by the commission. Factfinders appointed by the commission, including other than commission members serving as factfinders, are entitled to reimbursement for expenses in the same manner as members of the commission and to compensation as established by the commission.
 - **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 15.1-16-03 of the North Dakota Century Code as created by House Bill No. 1045, as approved by the fifty-seventh legislative assembly, is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - **15.1-16-03.** Education factfinding commission Compensation. Each member of the commission is entitled to receive compensation at the rate of sixty-two eighty dollars and fifty cents per day and reimbursement for expenses, as provided by law for state officers, for attending commission meetings or performing duties directed by the commission.

- **SECTION 3. AMENDMENT.** Section 15.1-16-04 of the North Dakota Century Code as created by House Bill No. 1045, as approved by the fifty-seventh legislative assembly, is amended and reenacted as follows:
- **15.1-16-04.** Education factfinders Compensation. Each factfinder appointed by the education factfinding commission, including each other than a commission member who serves as a factfinder, is entitled to receive compensation at the rate of sixty-two eighty dollars and fifty eents per day and reimbursement for expenses, as provided by law for state officers, for attending commission meetings or performing duties directed by the commission.
