- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 39-10-73 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to passengers in a vehicle; and to amend and reenact section 39-06.1-08 of the North
- 3 Dakota Century Code, relating to nonmoving violations.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA: 4

- 5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 39-06.1-08 of the 1999 Supplement to the North 6
 - Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 7 **39-06.1-08.** Nonmoving violation defined. For the purposes of section 39-06.1-06, a 8 "nonmoving violation" means:
- 9 A violation of section 39-04-11, subsection 6 of section 39-06-17, and section 10 39-06-44, 39-06-45, 39-10-47, 39-10-49, 39-10-50, 39-10-51, 39-10-54.1, 11 39-10-73, 39-21-08, 39-21-10, 39-21-11, or 39-21-14, or a violation of any 12 municipal ordinance equivalent to the foregoing sections.
 - A violation, discovered at a time when the vehicle is not actually being operated, of section 39-21-03, 39-21-05, 39-21-13, 39-21-19, 39-21-32, 39-21-37, 39-21-39, or 39-21-44.2, or a violation of any municipal ordinance equivalent to the foregoing sections.
- 17 **SECTION 2.** Section 39-10-73 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows: 18
- 19 39-10-73. Location of passengers.
- The operator of a vehicle that is being operated on a highway may not allow an 20 1. 21 individual under eighteen years of age to ride on any portion of the vehicle not 22 designed for transporting passengers.

individual being transported in an emergency situation.
