1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the effect of obesity on health

2 care costs and methods to expand awareness of the problem of obesity and improve treatment

3 modalities.

4 **WHEREAS**, obesity ranks second to smoking as a preventable cause of death; and

5 WHEREAS, the United States Centers for Disease Control and Prevention reports that 6 the obesity rate among North Dakota adults has increased from 12.9 percent in 1991 to 18.7

7 percent in 1998; and

8 WHEREAS, a causal relationship exists between obesity and a number of serious
9 disorders, including hypertension, dyslipidemia, cardiovascular disease, type-two diabetes, gall
10 bladder disease, respiratory dysfunction, gout, and osteoarthritis; and

11 WHEREAS, a 1997 study by Kaiser Permanente concluded that there is a significant

12 potential for reduction in health care expenditures through obesity prevention efforts; and

WHEREAS, it is critical to raise the awareness of the public and private sectors that
although obesity is a disease of epidemic proportions, obesity is a treatable disease;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

That the Legislative Council study the effect of obesity on health care costs and
 methods to expand awareness of the problem of obesity and improve treatment modalities; and
 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and

recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
the Fifty-eighth Legislative Assembly.
