

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3016

1 A concurrent resolution urging Congress to make grain grading for federal crop insurance more
2 equivalent to industry standards.

3 **WHEREAS**, federal crop insurance is purchased as a risk management tool; and

4 **WHEREAS**, federal crop insurance does not adequately address the risks present in the
5 production of wheat; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the industry uses stricter standards in discounting wheat to feed prices than
7 those used for payment of federal crop insurance; and

8 **WHEREAS**, the industry deeply discounts or purchases at feed prices based upon
9 many other factors besides the limited factors used for federal crop insurance;

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES**
11 **OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

12 That the Fifty-seventh Legislative Assembly urges the Congress of the United States to
13 make grain grading for federal crop insurance more equivalent to industry standards; and

14 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Secretary of State forward copies of this
15 resolution to the Federal Crop Insurance Corporation, the Secretary of the Department of
16 Agriculture, and to each member of the North Dakota Congressional Delegation.
