4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE

SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

That the Fifty-seventh Legislative Assembly urges the Congress of the United States to propose to the several states for ratification an amendment to the Constitution of the United States to repeal the seventeenth amendment and to provide that after ratification of the amendment, upon expiration of the term of office of each United States Senator holding office at the time of ratification, the legislature of each state shall choose the state's senators as originally provided in section 3 of article I of the Constitution of the United States; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of State forward copies of this resolution to the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, the President of the United States Senate, and the members of the North Dakota Congressional Delegation.
