HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3030

1	A concurrent resolution urging Congress to increase Medicare reimbursement for rural health
2	care providers and to use an appropriate amount of the federal budget surplus to equalize
3	Medicare rates between eastern and western North Dakota.
4	WHEREAS, North Dakota's Medicare recipients are entitled to the same health care
5	services as other senior citizens in the United States; and
6	WHEREAS, Medicare has historically reimbursed rural health care providers at a
7	considerably lower rate than urban health care providers; and
8	WHEREAS, there is great disparity among North Dakota providers; and
9	WHEREAS, there is a need for access to emergency care and primary care in rural
10	North Dakota which is jeopardized by inadequate Medicare reimbursement;
11	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
12	OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
13	That the Fifty-seventh Legislative Assembly urges the Congress of the United States to
14	increase Medicare reimbursement for rural health care providers and to use an appropriate
15	amount of the federal budget surplus to equalize Medicare rates between eastern and western
16	North Dakota; and
17	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Fifty-seventh Legislative Assembly invites the
18	United States Senate Finance Committee to meet in North Dakota to address these concerns
19	related to Medicare; and
20	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of State forward copies of this
21	resolution to the Secretary of the United States Department of Health and Human Services, to
22	the chairman of the United States Senate Finance Committee, to the chairman of the United
23	States House of Representatives Committee on Ways and Means, and to each member of the
24	North Dakota Congressional Delegation.
