1	A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the impact on domestic
2	relations law of using the term "parental responsibility" in lieu of "custody" and "parenting time"
3	in lieu of "visitation".
4	WHEREAS, more than half of all civil actions filed in district courts involve domestic
5	relations cases, including divorce, separation, custody proceedings, support actions, adoptions,
6	and paternity proceedings; and
7	WHEREAS, the existing judicial system provides for an adversarial proceeding for
8	domestic relations cases which often compounds the negative impact of family dissolutions;
9	and
10	WHEREAS, state law provides that a mother and father have equal rights with regard to
11	the care, custody, education, and control of the children of the marriage; and
12	WHEREAS, the concept of mutual parental responsibility should be encouraged; and
13	WHEREAS, typically, the most acrimonious portion of a divorce proceeding involves the
14	custody and visitation issues; and
15	WHEREAS, as used in domestic relations law, the terms "custody" and "visitation" have
16	the effect of alienating parties;
17	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
18	OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
19	That the Legislative Council study the impact on domestic relations law of using the
20	term "parental responsibility" in lieu of "custody" and "parenting time" in lieu of "visitation"; and
