

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3067

Introduced by

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the feasibility and desirability
2 of establishing a behavior modification academy for certain adult and juvenile offenders.

3 **WHEREAS**, certain violations of the law are related to emotional or financial problems
4 or are not violent or serious in nature; and

5 **WHEREAS**, these violations of the law include the crimes of driving while under the
6 influence, issuing of nonsufficient fund checks, and certain misdemeanors and nonviolent
7 crimes; and

8 **WHEREAS**, these violations of the law may be committed by a juvenile who is not
9 considered a threat to that juvenile's own life or the life or safety of other persons; and

10 **WHEREAS**, by addressing the causes of the behavior that are related to these
11 violations of the law, future violations may be diminished and the former offender returned to a
12 productive place in society;

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES**
14 **OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

15 That the Legislative Council study the feasibility and desirability of establishing a
16 behavior modification academy for certain adult and juvenile offenders; and

17 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
18 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
19 the Fifth-eighth Legislative Assembly.
