| 10 | WHEREAS, by addressing the causes of the behavior that are related to these |
| 11 | violations of the law, future violations may be diminished and the former offender returned to a |
| 12 | productive place in society; |
| 13 | NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES |
| 14 | OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN: |
| 15 | That the Legislative Council study the feasibility and desirability of establishing a |
