

SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 4049

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study limiting actions for lead-based
2 paint claims.

3 **WHEREAS**, the presence of lead-based paint in public buildings may cause significant
4 environmental and health concerns; and

5 **WHEREAS**, it may be in the best interests of the general public, particularly for those
6 persons who may bring claims regarding lead-based paint in public buildings and those against
7 whom the claims may be brought, to set a specific date by which public building owners must
8 bring a cause of action for removal or other abatement costs associated with the presence of
9 lead-based paint in their buildings;

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE**
11 **HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:**

12 That the Legislative Council study limiting actions for lead-based paint claims; and

13 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
14 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
15 the Fifty-eighth Legislative Assembly.
