1 A memorial resolution in memory of John T. Schneider.

2 **WHEREAS**, on March 9, 2001, God summoned to eternal rest John T. Schneider, who
3 served in the 48th through 52nd Legislative Assemblies, from District 21; and

4 **WHEREAS**, John T. Schneider served as the minority leader in the North Dakota House
5 of Representatives in the 51st and 52nd Legislative Assemblies; and

6 **WHEREAS**, John T. Schneider served his country as an officer in the United States
7 Marine Corps and through a rigorous assignment with the Peace Corps in Afghanistan; and

8 **WHEREAS**, John T. Schneider served seven years as United States Attorney, this
9 state's top federal law enforcement officer, from 1993 to 2000; and

10 **WHEREAS**, John T. Schneider was a husband to Lois, a father to Jasper and Rocky,
11 and a friend and colleague to the House of Representatives and the people of this state; and

12 **WHEREAS**, we now pause to mourn the passing of our former House colleague and
13 honor his memory for his outstanding service to the people of this state by his contributions to
14 public service;

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES**
16 **OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

17 That we express our sorrow on the passing of John T. Schneider and show our
18 appreciation, on behalf of the people of North Dakota, for the loyal and devoted service of our
19 former colleague; and

20 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that for the perpetuation of his memory this token of
21 respect and sympathy by his successors in trust be printed in the Journal of the House and that
22 the Secretary of State present enrolled copies of this resolution to his widow and children.
