1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state historical

2 society; and to declare an emergency.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the 5 funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state 6 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and 7 other income, to the state historical society for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the 8 state historical society, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2003, as follows: 9 10 Salaries and wages \$4,717,780 11 1,129,334 Operating expenses 12 185,744 Equipment 13 Capital improvements 1,159,200 14 Capital improvements - Fort Buford 3,543,160 15 Grants 485,559 Yellowstone-Missouri-Fort Union Commission 16 4,727 17 Lewis and Clark bicentennial 1,398,844 18 Total all funds \$12,624,348 19 Less estimated income 5,614,946 20 Total general fund appropriation \$7,009,402

SECTION 2. SPECIAL ROAD FUND. The amount of \$30,000, or such lesser amount as may be available, included in the Lewis and Clark bicentennial and estimated income line items in section 1 of this Act is from the special road fund and must be used for roadway and parking lot improvements at the Fort Clark state historic site. - 2 in section 1 of this Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
