#### 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the parks and

2 recreation department and the International Peace Garden.

#### 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the 5 funds as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in 6 the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal 7 funds and other income, to the parks and recreation department for the purpose of defraying 8 the expenses of its various divisions, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2001, and ending 9 June 30, 2003, as follows: 10 Subdivision 1. # 4 SECTION 2. FUNDING - INTERNATIONAL PEACE GARDEN AND THE

5 **INTERNATIONAL PEACE GARDEN FOUNDATION.** The director of the parks and recreation 6 department shall transfer from the amount appropriated in the International Peace Garden line 7 item in subdivision 2 of section 1 of this Act a total of \$364,583 to the International Peace 8 Garden and a total of \$12,500 to the International Peace Garden foundation, a United States 9 corporation. The transfers to the International Peace Garden must be made in two amounts; 10 \$182,292 transferred within ten days of July 1, 2001, and \$182,291 transferred within ten days 11 of July 1, 2002. The transfer to the International Peace Garden foundation must be made only 12 when the foundation has raised \$12,500 of other funds to be used to match the funds 13 appropriated in subdivision 2 of section 1 of this Act. The parks and recreation department may 14 not reduce the funds appropriated in the International Peace Garden line item in subdivision 2 15 of section 1 of this Act by a percentage greater than any percentage allotment of general fund 16 moneys required of the department pursuant to the provisions of sections 54-44.1-12 and 17 54-44.1-13.1.

SECTION 3. SNOWMOBILE FUND. The amount of \$600,000, or so much of the
 amount as is necessary, included in the estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act, is
 from the snowmobile fund for the biennium beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2003.
 SECTION 4. TRAIL TAX TRANSFER FUND. The amount of \$50,000, or so much of
 the amount as is necessary, included in the estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act,
 is from the trail tax transfer fund for the biennium beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30,
 2003.

SECTION 5. STATE PARKS GIFT FUND. The amount of \$200,000, or so much of the
amount as is necessary, included in the estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act, is
from the state parks gift fund for the biennium beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30,
2003.
