4	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this	section, or so much of the
5	funds as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in	
6	the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from other	
7	income, to the tourism department for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the tourism	
8	department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2003, as follows:
