- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 54-27-21 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the minimum value for reporting fixed assets; and to declare an emergency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 54-27-21 of the 1999 Supplement to the North
Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

54-27-21. Fixed asset minimum reporting value. All state departments, agencies,
boards, bureaus, commissions, industries, and institutions shall include all fixed assets under
their control in their financial statements, except those having a value of seven hundred and
fifty five thousand dollars or less. The state auditor is authorized to provide for the written
exemption of specific fixed assets having a value of more than seven hundred and fifty five
thousand dollars when such an exemption is justified upon generally accepted accounting
principles.

13 **SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
