1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 37-07.2-01 of the North Dakota Century Code,

2 relating to tuition grants to national guard members.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 37-07.2-01 of the 1999 Supplement to the North
Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

6 37-07.2-01. National guard tuition grants - Terms of grants. Any qualifying member 7 of the national guard who enrolls in any private nonprofit college or university in North Dakota 8 granting a four-year baccalaureate degree or enrolls in a qualifying trade school may, subject to 9 the limitations of available appropriated funds and subject to national guard rules promulgated 10 by the adjutant general, receive a grant in an amount equal to the payments made pursuant to 11 chapter 37-07.1 for similar courses and credit hours for each qualifying member of the national 12 guard who is enrolled at the university of North Dakota. Any private nonprofit college or 13 university or qualifying trade school that agrees to participate in such a program must waive 14 tuition for qualifying national quardsmen guard members in an amount equal to the difference 15 between the tuition grant received by the national guard member and the tuition charged for 16 similar courses and credit hours at the university of North Dakota. The use of the grant may not 17 be restricted to the payment of tuition fees by the member of the national guard. These grants must be distributed according to rules promulgated by the adjutant general and are available 18 19 only so long as the member maintains satisfactory performance with the guard, meets the 20 gualification requirements of the rules, and pursues a course of study which satisfies the normal 21 requirements of the school. As used in this chapter the word "tuition" has the same meaning as 22 provided in section 37-07.1-02.
