- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 37-10-03.2 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the authority of the adjutant general to lease or vacate property.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 37-10-03.2 of the 1999 Supplement to the North
  Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 37-10-03.2. Exchange, sale, and lease of military lands. The adjutant general may
   exchange or sell lands owned by the state of North Dakota and used for military purposes with
- 8 other agencies of the state, counties, municipalities or other political subdivisions, corporations,
- 9 limited liability companies, or individuals or to any person, and may purchase, within funds
- 10 available, parcels of land necessary for the construction of armories or the expansion of present
- 11 military installations in the state of North Dakota. Sales must be made under the provisions of
- 12 sections 54-01-05.1 and 54-01-05.2 and all net proceeds of sales must be placed in the
- 13 national guard training area and facility development trust fund. The adjutant general may
- 14 lease parts of military installations to the department of defense or other agencies of the federal
- 15 government any person. Land originally acquired from a county, city, or political subdivision for
- 16 nominal consideration may be vacated by the adjutant general and conveyed back to the
- 17 county, city, or political subdivision when the land is no longer necessary for military purposes.
