AN ACT to amend and reenact section 32-03.1-05 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to liability for providing emergency medical aid.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 32-03.1-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

32-03.1-05. Exceptions. This chapter shall does not encompass any a person who, at the time of the emergency, was employed expressly or actually for the purpose of providing emergency medical aid to humans, either within or outside of a hospital or other place or vehicle with medical equipment, for emergency medical aid or other assistance rendered in the regular course of their employment. Such persons and their employers shall be are liable for their acts and omissions in rendering emergency medical aid in the regular course of their employment, according to the prevailing law in this state in existence on July 1, 1987.
